### Adverbs of Frequency - Grammar Notes

**Point 1:** We use adverbs of frequency to show how often we do something.

1. I **always** have coffee in the morning.
2. I **usually** eat dinner at home.
3. I **sometimes** eat a restaurants.
4. I **never** drink alcohol.

**Point 2:** Adverbs of time and relative strength.

1. Always (100%)
2. Almost always
3. Usually
4. Often
5. Sometimes
6. Hardly ever / Rarely
7. Almost never
8. Never (0%)

**Point 3:** Adverbs of time can be used immediately in front of the verb.

1. Thomas **almost always** paints in the evening.
2. She **usually** gets to work early.
3. We **hardly ever** rent movies.
4. I **never** stay out late.

**Point 4:** *Sometimes, usually and often* can go before the subject or at the end of the verb phrase.

1. **Usually**, I read before bed.
2. I read before bed **usually**.
3. **Often** I go there.
4. I go there **often**.
5. **Sometimes**, I play tennis at night.
6. I play tennis at night **sometimes**.
